

Special Terms for SkanMate

These special terms apply to customers' use of **SkanMate** and supplement SkanCode A/S' general standard terms and conditions. In the event of any conflict, these special terms shall prevail with respect to SkanMate.

1. Nature of the Agreement

SkanMate leveres som en cloudbaseret softwareløsning (SaaS) til erhvervskunder. Aftalen er en løbende abonnementsaftale.

2. Subscription and Billing

Depending on your selection, the SkanMate subscription is invoiced in advance for either 3 months or 12 months.

All subscriptions begin with a 30-day free trial period.

The subscription continues until terminated in accordance with the termination provisions below.

3. Termination

After expiry of the free trial period, the agreement may be terminated by either party with notice corresponding to the current quarter + 3 months.

Termination must be made in writing and takes effect upon expiry of the notice period.

Termination does not release the Customer from payment obligations for subscriptions that have commenced or been invoiced prior to the termination date.

4. Prices and Payment Terms

The applicable prices and payment methods at any time are available on SkanMate.com and may be changed with one month's notice to the end of a calendar quarter. All prices are exclusive of VAT.

Failure to make timely payment constitutes breach of contract and may result in suspension of access to SkanMate following prior notice.

5. Data Processing (GDPR)

To the extent that SkanCode A/S processes personal data on behalf of the Customer in connection with the delivery of SkanMate, such processing is carried out in accordance with a separate data processing agreement, which constitutes an independent appendix to the agreement.

The data processing agreement is deemed accepted simultaneously with the Customer's acceptance of these terms and forms an integral part of the contractual basis. In the event of conflict between these terms and the data processing agreement, the data processing agreement shall prevail with respect to the processing of personal data.

6. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

The agreement is governed by Danish law. Any dispute shall be settled by the **District Court of Hillerød** as the court of first instance.
